Modern Stone's Easy Etch removes grout and mortar smears, mineral deposits and rust stains. This industrial strength concentrated acid based cleaner is specially formulated to etch grout to bond with Modern Stone's Color Sealer. Use on acid-resistant tile, stone or masonry surfaces. This product is not for use on natural stone surfaces such as flagstone, marble, travertine, limestone or any other acid sensitive surface. A pre-test for resistance should be performed prior to use.

USES

COVERAGE

» Grout

Approximately 1,000 to 10,000 sq. ft. per gallon.

Use on acid-resistant tile, stone or masonry surfaces. Test in an inconspicuous area to determine acid resistance, ease of application and desired results.

Warning: This product is not for use on natural stone surfaces such as travertine, marble, limestone any other acid sensitive surface, such as stainless steel.

APPLICATION

- 1. Sweep or vacuum surface to remove loose debris.
- *Note: Mask off acid sensitive areas such as stainless steel and natural stone.
- 2. Dilute Easy Etch with water depending on cleaning task.
- * Light cleaning: Mix 1 part with 10 parts water.
- * Medium cleaning: Mix 1 part with 6 parts water.
- * Heavy cleaning/etching: Mix 1 part with 3 parts water.
- 3. Apply solution to area and allow to dwell 1-2 minutes. DO NOT allow to dry on surface.
- 4. Agitate with soft-bristle brush or acid resistant scrubber.
- 5. Remove dirty solution using a wet/dry vacuum, sponge, or damp mop.
- 6. Rinse thoroughly with clean water to remove residual cleaner.
- 7. Dry surface with terry cloth towel.

Handling & Storage:

Close container after each use. Store in original container only. Keep in a dry, well-ventilated area. Avoid freezing or long-term high temperature storage.

Caution:

Contains Phosphoric Acid. DO NOT mix with ammoniated cleaners as harmful fumes may result. PROTECT AREAS FROM OVERSPRAY. DO NOT USE ON STAINLESS STEEL OR OTHER BRUSHED METALS. Rubber gloves and eye protection should be worn during application. Avoid contact with eyes and skin. Immediately flush eyes with water for 20 minutes. If skin contact occurs wash with soap and water. Do not take internally. Do not induce vomiting. Seek medical attention.
